When the classes are over I go home (to the hostel). I have dinner and rest a little. Then I read textbooks and additional medical literature, make abstracts, and do some exercises. When I have spare time I watch TV, listen to the music or visit my friends or they come to visit me. I have a lot of friends and we often spend free time together, especially on Sundays. At 11 o'clock I go to bed. As I work hard I do sleep well.

Summary. Medical students must remember that it is not easy to be a good specialist. A real specialist must love not only his profession, but also be kind to people who come to him for help.
