- A.** Honey is a type of food made by honeybees from nectar. They put the honey into a honeycomb, which is a storage unit for them. Honey is sweet and can be used instead of sugar. Honey tastes quite different according to which flowers were used by the bees. The key features are its fragrance (smell), taste and how clear it is.
- B.** Farming is growing crops or keeping animals by people for food and raw materials. Farming is a part of agriculture. Agriculture started thousands of years ago, but no one knows for sure how old it is. People may have started farming because the weather and soil began to change. Farming can feed many more people than hunting on the same amount of land.
